

**City of Aberdeen  
Transportation Benefit District  
Effective July 1, 2019**

**Effective July 1, 2019**, the City of Aberdeen will extend and increase the Transportation Benefit District (TBD) sales and use tax rate. The tax of eighteen-one hundredths of one percent (0.0018) will be used for transportation services.

Businesses must collect the appropriate new rate of sales tax for retail sales and services provided within the City of Aberdeen (1401). Persons or businesses within the City of Aberdeen will be subject to the new rate of use tax on items purchased for their personal or business use if sales tax has not been paid.

The new rate of sales tax is:
