LOCAL SALES TAX CHANGE

**Whitman County Juvenile Detention Tax
 Effective January 1, 2006**

Effective January 1, 2006, Sales and use tax within all of Whitman County will increase one-tenth of one percent (.001). The new rate county wide will be 7.7%. The tax will be used for jails and juvenile detention purposes.

Businesses must collect the appropriate new rate of sales tax for retail sales and services provided within the county. Persons or businesses within Whitman County will be subject to the new rate of use tax on items purchased for their personal or business use if sales tax has not been paid.

The new rates of sales tax are:
