

WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE LOCAL SALES TAX CHANGE

City of Olympia Housing and Related Services Effective July 1, 2018

Effective July 1, 2018, local sales and use tax within the City of Olympia will increase one-tenth of one percent (.001). The tax will be used for housing and related services.

Businesses must collect the appropriate new rate of sales tax for retail sales and services provided within the City of Olympia (3403). Persons or businesses within the City of Olympia will be subject to the new tax rate for reporting use tax on items purchased for their personal or business use if sales tax has not been paid.

The new rate of sales tax is:
