

Snohomish County Tourism Promotion Area (TPA) Lodging Charge Rate Change

Effective July 1, 2020, all unincorporated areas and some cities within Snohomish County Tourism Promotion Area (TPA) have adopted an ordinance authorizing an increase in the rate of special assessments (lodging charges) within the established TPA. TPA lodging charge will increase to two dollars (\$2.00) per room per night of stay. Lodging businesses within the TPA with 50 or more rooms must collect the lodging charge from persons who purchase lodging.

What to Collect and Report:

Snohomish County lodging businesses within the TPA are identified in the following chart:

Lodging Facilities that Report the TPA Lodging Charge:

“Lodging businesses,” for the purpose of this charge, include hotels, motels, and bed and breakfast facilities located within the Snohomish County TPA with forty (50) or more lodging units.

If you have less than 50 rooms, or if your lodging business is not within the boundaries of the Snohomish County TPA, you do not need to report the TPA charge.
