

City of Mount Vernon Transportation Benefit District Effective April 1, 2017

Effective April 1, 2017, the City of Mount Vernon will establish a Transportation Benefit District (TBD). Sales and use tax within the City of Mount Vernon will increase two-tenths of one percent (.002). The tax will be used for transportation services.

Businesses must collect the appropriate new rate of sales tax for retail sales and services provided within the City of Mount Vernon (2907). Persons or businesses within the City of Mount Vernon will be subject to the new tax rate for reporting use tax on items purchased for their personal or business use if sales tax has not been paid.
