

City of Olympia Cultural Access Programs Effective January 1, 2023

Effective January 1, 2023, local sales and use tax within the City of Olympia will increase one-tenth of one percent (.001). The tax will be used for cultural access programs.

Businesses must collect the appropriate new rate of sales tax for retail sales and services provided within the City of Olympia (3403). Persons or businesses within the City of Olympia will be subject to the new tax rate of use tax on items purchased for their personal or business use if sales tax has not been paid.

The new rate of sales tax is:
