San Juan County Emergency Communication Tax Effective July 1, 2025

Effective July 1, 2025, local sales and use tax within San Juan County will decrease fifteen one hundredths of one percent (0.0015) to comply with initial imposition of the Emergency Communication Tax. The remaining five one hundredth of one percent (0.0005) of tax will be used for emergency communication systems and facilities.

Businesses must collect the appropriate new rate of sales tax for retail sales and services provided within San Juan County. Persons or businesses within San Juan County will be subject to the new rate of use tax on items purchased for their personal or business use if sales tax has not been paid.

The new rates of sales tax are:
