

City of Stevenson Transportation Benefit District Effective July 1, 2025

Effective July 1, 2025, the City of Stevenson Transportation Benefit District will impose an additional three-tenths of one percent (.003) for sales and use tax within the City of Stevenson. The tax will be used for transportation services.

Businesses must collect the appropriate new rate of sales tax for retail sales and services provided within the City of Stevenson (3002). Persons or businesses within the City of Stevenson will be subject to the new rate of use tax on items purchased for their personal or business use if sales tax has not been paid.

The new rate of sales tax is:
