## NOTES ON THE LOCAL TAX DISTRIBUTIONS REPORT

**Overview**—Local tax distributions are funds sent to cities, counties, and other local governments by the Office of the State Treasurer. The Department of Revenue (department) collects the local taxes and then sends them to the correct local jurisdiction. Each distribution represents local tax amounts paid to the department in the previous month. (Example: March 2021 distribution generally includes the January 2021 return due in February 2021). Distributions are monthly; however, if a business does not pay in full, local jurisdictions receive partial distributions until the business pays the full amount. This annual report is a compilation of the monthly reports for the period November 2023 through October 2024.

**On-demand data access**—In addition to this annual report, users can access the local tax distribution data on demand for years 1983 to present. [Local tax distribution queries](#) (click on Local Tax distribution under the Reports and Tools menu) from 2012 to present allow the users to view data by single or all locations without using separate queries. Users select search criteria including year, month, tax, and location. The user can filter search results on-screen or export to a spreadsheet or HTML.

[Local tax distribution queries from 1983 to 2011](#) require separate queries for single locations and all locations.

**Data presentation**—The format used in this annual report differs from the format used in the monthly report on the department's website. The tax types are sales/use taxes, lodging taxes, and rental car/other taxes. It includes figures for both the most recent complete calendar year and the prior year, and includes a computation of the percentage change in distribution amounts from one year to the next. The state administration fee and the E911 number of lines are not included in the annual report.

All users of this data should take caution when attempting to determine the causes of individual percentage changes. Distributions can fluctuate dramatically due to population changes, annexations and incorporations, and audit adjustments.
